Description

The id code for a protection area as it is in the environmental information system Hertta's register of protected areas. Three first letters of the code describe the conservation programme area is included in. The next 2 numbers describe the administrative municipality in the old system before 1.9.1997. Last 4 numbers are serial numbers specific for the protection area (e.g. KAO0400066).

Nimi

The name of the rocky area

Luokka

The protection area type (KAO = Valuable Rocky Areas)

DigPohja

Shows the scale of the base map used for digitizing. Peruscd = Topographical base map (1:20 000) and nkrk = (numeric cadastral maps)

DigOrg

The organization responsible for the first data digitizing

MuutosPvm

Date when the dataset has been modified

Arvoluokka

Value classification

1 = Unique rocky area

2 = Extremely valuable rocky area

3 = Very valuable rocky area

4 = Valuable rocky area

5 = Moderately valuable rocky area

6 = **Slightly valuable rocky area**

7 = Landscape and nature values of the area are low

Note: when the information is exported as shape files, the name of the field will have only 10 digits.
